<b>Legal Basis for Processing</b>	The organization received consent to handle the personal information. The organization is under contract to handle the personal information. The organization has a legitimate business interest in handling the information.
<b>Automated Processing or Profiling</b>	Automated processing occurs.
<b>If Automated Processing is Used, Methods and Logic</b>	The automated systems use a rating system to determine insurance eligibility and rates for certain insurance services including Prime's animal liability, motorcycle express, pilot liability and tax preparer policies.
<b>Decisions with a Legal Effect that Use Automated Processing</b>	Prime uses the automated processing to determine insurance rates for certain insurance services including Prime's animal liability, motorcycle express, pilot liability and tax preparer policies.
<b>Categories of Recipients who Receive this Personal Data</b>	Prime may share the information with approved third-party vendors including: affiliates, subsidiaries, marketing partners, government entities, cloud storage providers, web analytics, payment processors, law firms, claims adjusters, and internet service providers.

<b>Whether the Personal Data is Transferred Outside of the European Economic Area</b>	The United States of America.
<b>Retention Period</b>	Prime retains the information for as long as necessary for Prime to fulfill its legitimate business purpose and legal and contractual obligations to the customer.

**Your rights with regard to the data we collect:**

As a Data Subject in the European Economic Area, you have the right to request, access, rectify, erase, and restrict how we process your Personal Data. These rights include the ability to review the Personal Data we have in our Information and Communications systems concerning you, the ability to make any corrections to that Personal Data, the ability to be informed of who that data may have been shared with, the ability to request that we erase all of our Personal Data, and the ability to restrict how we Process your Personal Data.

We are required to respond to any of your requests to exercise these above Data Subject rights within 30 days. Should we be unable to comply within 30 days, we will contact you anyway and let you know of any delay.
